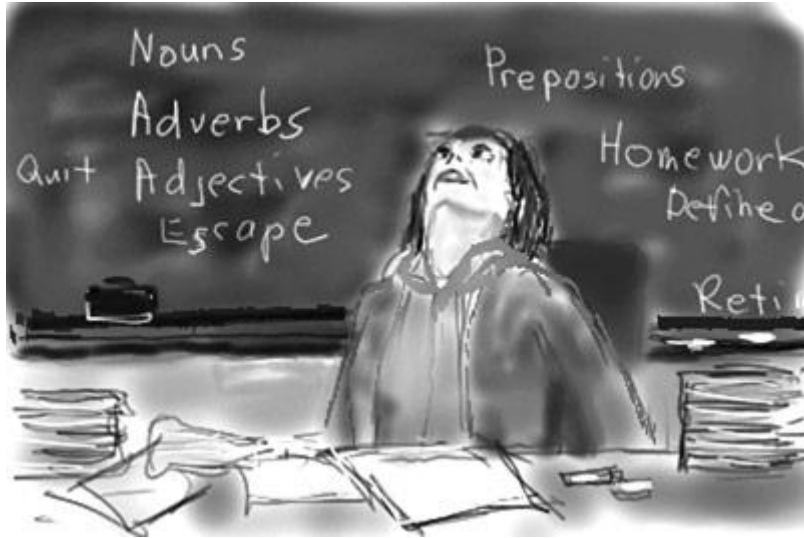


## DO THE CAPS CAP IT ALL?
